

# Northern Forest Initiative (NFI)

Forest Restoration in North Macedonia and Albania



# **Project Overview**

The NFI project aims to prevent further forest loss in North Macedonia and Albania through restoration in key biodiversity landscapes and strengthening capacities for sustainable forest management.

This project applies Nature-based Solutions (NbS) for Forest Landscape Restoration (FLR) and contributes to the conservation of species like the critically endangered Balkan Lynx.

### **Problem Statement**

In the past 20 years, North Macedonia and Albania lost a significant part of their tree cover, with more recent studies showing continued degradation in high biodiversity regions.

These areas, home to iconic wildlife such as the Balkan Lynx, wolves, and bears, are particularly vulnerable to illegal logging, urbanization, and the effects of climate change.

Local communities are also threatened by wildfires, pests, and diseases, leading to a reduction in forest ecosystem resilience.

While governments and CSOs have undertaken some conservation efforts, comprehensive approaches for forest management remain underdeveloped, and forest loss continues to outpace restoration efforts.



## **Project Activities**

The NFI Project will implement Forest Landscape Restoration (FLR) in two key areas:




**Bukovik** in North Macedonia



#### Pashtrik-Morina in Albania

Using the ROAM (Restoration Opportunities Assessment Methodology), the project has prioritized these sites for their biodiversity value and potential for restoration.

This restoration work will have multiple benefits, including improved carbon sequestration, increased ecosystem resilience, and restored ecological connectivity between protected areas.
